How to make a blanket

- 1. Line up the layers of fleece as closely as possible and use safety pins to pin the pieces together, so they don't slip around while you're working on the blanket. Make sure the safety pins are at least 4" from the edge, so they're not in the fringe cutting area.
- 2. Place masking tape strips 4" from the edge, all the way around. We'll use these as a cutting guide.
- 3. Cut the 4 corners out (4x4" squares)
- 4. Draw marks at one inch intervals on the masking tape, all the way around. Fringes will be 4" long and 1" wide.
- 5. Cut the fringes all the way around the blanket. Cut from the edge, to the tape, at the marks that you drew in the previous step.
- 6. Tie fringes. Double-tie the top layer to the bottom layer of each fringe. Don't pull too tight, or the blanket will bunch up, but make sure the knots are secure enough that they will stay tied.
- 7. Remove the masking tape and the safety pins.
- 8. You're done!
